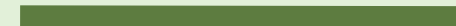

- ❖ Merit list of the candidates will be prepared on the basis of results of Higher Secondary or equivalent examinations and their preferences of study. Statutory seats reservation and relaxation policies are applicable as per govt. rules.
- ❖ The selection process for those who wish to take Major in Performing arts will be based on the results of the higher secondary or equivalent examinations and face to face interview with the candidates.
